

Nazis Confiscate Art Objects From Homes Of Jews

MUNICH, Nov. 17—(AP)—Three representatives of the German Culture Chamber began to seize objects of art Thursday night from the homes of Munich Jews.

Among the articles taken and packed in vans were antique furniture, pictures and china regarded as "cultural assets of the German nation." The art objects will be stored in the Munich Museum.

Scores of Jews were reported released from Dachau Concentration Camp Thursday night.
