GENERAL

- Open to English and Social Studies teachers, grades 6-12, for the study of the Holocaust at nationally recognized Holocaust training centers.
- Awards cover 100% of registration fees plus travel, lodging, and per diem as determined by the BHEC. The number of scholarships awarded will be based on available funds.



REQUIREMENTS

- Requirements for ALL Scholarship Recipients
 - Currently teaching the Holocaust in the classroom.
 - Four (4) or more years from retirement.
 - Must include Holocaust studies in the classroom curriculum for a minimum of three (3) years.
- Requirements for JFR Scholarships ONLY
 - Minimum five (5) years teaching experience.
 - Prior completion of at least one (1) Holocaust-related professional development program.



DEADLINES

- Monday, November 28, 2016
Applications will be accepted for Birmingham teachers only.
- Monday, December 19, 2016
Applications will be accepted for teachers throughout the state.
- Friday, January 20, 2017
All scholarship applications due.
