## GENERAL

- Open to English and Social Studies teachers throughout the state of Alabama, grades 6-12, for study at nationally recognized Holocaust training centers.
- Scholarships cover 100% of registration fees plus travel, lodging, and per diem as determined by the BHEC. Number of Scholarships awarded will be based on available funds.



## REQUIREMENTS

### Requirements for ALL Scholarship Recipients

- Currently teaching the Holocaust in the classroom.
- Four (4) or more years from retirement.
- Prior completion of at least one (1) BHEC professional development program.
- Must include Holocaust studies in the classroom curriculum for a minimum of three (3) years after the scholarship.

### Additional requirements for JFR Summer Institute and European Study Programs

- Minimum five (5) years teaching experience.

Applications will be accepted for Summer 2020.
- **Friday, January 17, 2020**  
All scholarship applications due.
- **Friday, January 31, 2020**  
Scholarship recipients notified by the BHEC.
